ATTENTION- *With Spring and Summer approaching, the City wants to remind everyone when mowing to please blow all yard clippings back into your yard rather than on the streets and sidewalks. Be advised of the following codes:*

- Ordinance No. 535: Riding bicycles, scooters or skateboards on sidewalks, motorized bicycles prohibited. No person shall ride a bicycle, scooter or skateboard upon a sidewalk within a business district in the City of Paris.



- Section 215.015 No grass or weeds over seven inches in height.

-Friendly Springtime Reminder: Don't forget to renew your permit on your golf cart or ATV. Monroe County Sheriff's office will prepare an inspection, review your proof of insurance and collect your \$15.00 fee for the year.
