**Mowing Season Reminders!** Please mow away from the curb to avoid blowing grass clippings and leaves into the street. We also ask that you be mindful of the length of your grass/weeds. Per City Ordinance: length should not exceed 7" in height.

**Reminder –** Yard Waste is picked up the **FIRST** and **THIRD** Friday only. The brush dump is accessible to all and located at the end of Brasch Drive. Cameras are located on the premises to control abuse of availability. Although we do not require limbs to be placed in bags/boxes, we do ask that you bag up any and all leaves.
